

## Prayer Guide - April through June 2017

We invite you to pray that the Holy Spirit would use us to go into our communities with hearts of service and voices that share the good news of Jesus Christ, multiplying the harvest in all our churches.

## Pray during the week of:

**April 2 –** We give thanks to the Lord for blessing St. Paul, Aurora, with another new start called, 1MPH; One Message, One Purpose, One Hour. We give thanks for God blessing them with over 100 people at their first service last month and ask for his continued wisdom and guidance as they reach out to their community with the love of Jesus!
