EARLY CHRISTIAN PREACHING/CATECHESIS: HANDLING A PLURALISTIC SOCIETY

What does preaching and catechesis look like in the New Testament and in the Patristic period? The Church is entering a period of time which looks more and more like the early days of Christianity. What must pastors consider as they engage in preaching within a pluralist society? What does the hearer need to hear?

Our conference sessions will consider major ideological shifts which have taken place in the Western world and its impact upon the piety and faith of Lutherans today. How do 'inquirers' see and hear the truth of God's Word? What does this mean in regards to their membership and participation within a congregational setting?

Major Greek themes predominate in the New Testament as the apostles preach and teach. A look into Clement of Alexandria's work "Προτρεπτικὸς πρὸς Έλληνας" (2^{nd} century) "Protrepticus: Exhortation to the Greeks" may aid our interaction with the passions and desires of the world, which in turn can place the focus onto the virtues and attributes of Christ.

Pastors: bring along your Greek New Testament...but sessions will not require it.

Rev. Professor Chad D. Kendall has been sole pastor of Trinity Lutheran Church, Lowell, Indiana for nearly twelve years. He served previously as associate pastor of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Spirit Lake, Iowa, for six years.

Pastor Kendall earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Management/Administration from Bradley University (Peoria, IL) in 1996 and received his Master of Divinity degree from Concordia Theological Seminary (Ft. Wayne, IN) in 2002 with a major in historical theology. He is currently a student in the Ph.D. in Missiology program at Concordia Theological Seminary (CTSFW). His doctoral thesis will consider how the Church should converse with the secular culture using an approach by Clement of Alexandria.

In addition to his pastoral care of souls at Trinity, Pastor Kendall serves as an adjunct professor at CTSFW and at Concordia University, Chicago teaching in the Master of Arts in Religion program as well as undergraduate courses. For the past three years, he has taught continuing education courses during the summer for CTSFW, and has various district conferences and video podcasts scheduled on addressing postmodernism and the passions of the soul. He has written articles in *Lutheran Witness, For the Life of the World*, and has an essay to be published in an upcoming Festschrift.

He is married to Stacie and has two sons, Isaac and Samuel.
